# **Rules & Regulations**

#### Team:

- A Team must furnish list of 16 Players (11 plus 5 substitute)
- The regular students of the school are only allowed/eligible to participate in this tournament.
- Must produce the school Identity Card before start of the Match
- If a team is short of players they need to start the match at scheduled time with the existing number of players

and any player report late will not be allowed after 2nd over.

- Match Time: 7.30 am to 5.30 pm on all days.

# **Equipment:-**

- Player's kit of equipment's consists of T-shirts, Lower with sport's shoes.
- Team T-shirt should be of uniform color for every match
- No player will be allowed to play bare foot/with chapels/ Sandals or formal shoes.
- Sport shoes are mandatory (any sports shoes).
- All the players are requested to bring their school Identity card and they shell display when requested. Team need to bring a letter from Principal/Sports Teacher with their name on it with sign and school seal.

### Tournament:-

- 10 over per innings
- Only two bowler are allowed a maximum of 3 overs, rest of the over can be shared by other bowlers.
- Yellow Vicky Tennis Ball A new ball per innings.

- There will not be LBWs. All other Cricket rules will be applied in the tournament.
- The team should report 30 minutes prior to the scheduled match time to sign the register and for briefing. Walkover time is 15 minutes from the match time.
- One bouncer in an over is allowed in an over provided the ball passes between the shoulder and the head. However, Ball passing over the head will be declared as a wide.
- A runner can be used only when a player gets injured during the innings or during fielding. A runner cannot be used for a player who is injured before the start of the match. The runner can be used only with the discretion of the umpires depending on the reason/cause.

# Restrictions on the placement of fieldsmen:

- For the first 3 over not more than two fielders will be allowed to field outside the inner-circle.
- After the first 3 over not more than five fielders will be allowed to field outside inner-circle.
- At the instant of delivery of the ball there should not be more than five fielders on the leg-side.
- In the event of infringement the umpire(s) will call and signal no ball.

#### **Tournament Format:-**

Knock-out:

Each team has to play 1 match to qualify for the knock out Round.

All teams will qualify for the knockout stage. If the Match ends in a draw there will be a Super over play of 6 balls! (3 batsmen only allowed playing from batting side)

# **Important Note:-**

The decision of the umpires will be final in all matters during the match.

All players are requested to carry the school ID card if required for Id proof.

No member of any team is to leave the field or enter the filed without prior permission of the umpire.

If any team walks out of the ground on protest during the playtime, the team will be disqualified from the tournament.

Before the start of each game, Captains of both teams shall be made aware of all the rules. Also they will have a chance to ask the Umpires about any clarifications that they may need. Once the match starts, no protests on the rules will be entertained during the match or after the match.

Matches will be played from 7.30 a.m. to 5.30p.m on all the days. Prize as mentioned on the Invitation!!! Please cooperate if any changed in the schedule or match timings.
