Rules for Registration

- Participants can enroll for the competition online.
- Registration is free of cost.
- Online registration link is available at http://indoreinstitute.com/registration for registering in all three competitions.
- Any Participant can take part in only one event.
- Last date of registration is October 30, 2018.
- Late entries will be entertained only on special request made by concerned School to the event coordinators.
- Decision of the Judges would be binding on all and no further requests on the same final and no correspondence or discussion will be entertained by the judges in relation to that decision.

Rules for Competition Conduction

Debate Competition

Topic: "Future of India is Bright despite the Current Challenges"

Rules:

- Teams can be formed for Debate.
- Each team will consist of two (2) students, one (1) in "Favor" of the motion and the other "Against" the motion.
- Each participant will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to speak. After 4 minutes of content delivery a buzzer will be sounded. Participant can take 1 more minute after buzzer to sum up.
- Evaluation would be done on the basis of relevance to the context, content delivery, time management, active participation, body language and voice modulation.

PowerPoint Presentation Competition

Following are the broad themes. Out of these four broad themes, students are free to pick up any one theme and get himself acquainted accordingly. Out of that broad theme picked up by him/her, a sub-theme will be provided to the him/her and they have to prepare a power point presentation on that sub-theme in computer lab of IIST.

- 1. Paradigm Shift in Nature of Business
- 2. Futuristic application of recent advancement in Science and Technology
- 3. Community Health Care System in India
- 4. Environmental Issues & Challenges and Solutions

Rules:

- A team consisting minimum of three (3) and maximum of five (5) student can participate.
- Team would be given 1.5 hours for preparation before the final submission of the presentation along with the internet facility (9:30 to 11:30).
- Each team would submit presentation online to the Administrator in the campus.
- Use of personal laptop will not be entertained.
- Teams will be given five (5) minutes for the presentation to judges and two (2) minutes for the discussion queries if any.
- Evaluation would be done on the basis of relevance to the topic, creativity, animations and graphics and other creativity used in the presentation.
